Welcome to the SIG listservs of the Academy of Consultation-Liaison Psychiatry (ACLP)

Thank you for being part of the Academy's online community. To ensure the best possible experience for all community members, we have established some basic guidelines for participation.

To preserve a climate that encourages both civil and fruitful dialogue, the Academy reserves the right to delete posts or terminate accounts for subscribers who violate these rules without advance notice or right of appeal.

Listserv Rules and Etiquette

- Lists work best when intelligent people bring fresh knowledge and ideas to the discussion. New ideas can stimulate discussion, but trivial or inane comments often kill it. Write thoughtful things and everyone will benefit from the list.
- No job postings please. Instead, post jobs in the Academy's Career Center, https://aclpjobs.careerwebsite.com/, where postings by members are free and which reaches C-L psychiatrists whether or not they are a member of the Academy.
- Don't attack others. Listserv discussions are meant to stimulate conversation not to create contention. Let others have their say, just as you may.
- Don't post commercial messages. While you might feel sure that symposium you're working hard on would be attractive to other C-L Psychiatrists, our listservs are not the place to post flyers or encourage customers.
- Listserv emails should not contain promotional material, special offers, job offers, product announcements, or solicitation for services. The Academy reserves the right to remove such messages and potentially ban sources of those solicitations.
- Do not, under any circumstances, post personally identifiable patient information. You have a duty • to protect the privacy of patients and the Academy cannot and does not guarantee that postings to our listservs are completely confidential or secure.
- Use caution when discussing products. Information posted on any platform is available for all to see, and comments are subject to libel, slander, and antitrust laws.



- All defamatory, abusive, profane, threatening, offensive, or illegal materials are strictly prohibited and may be removed.
- Do not post anything that you would not want the world to see or that you would not want anyone to know came from you. The Academy cannot and does not guarantee that postings to our listservs are confidential or secure.
- Be courteous. Please ask participants for permission to republish their words elsewhere (especially if elsewhere would be a publicly viewable setting).
- Don't clutter the list with 'I agree' or 'me too' or 'same here' or 'thank you' messages.
- Stick to the purpose of the list; the more topic-specific the contributions are, the more useful the list is for everyone. Make the subject line descriptive; "liver donor transplant problems" is more useful than "hello". Be brief, professional, clear, and logical. Vague subject lines (or no subject lines) are likely to be ignored or deleted.
- Don't forward virus alerts, chain letters, spam, solicitations, or flames (an abusive message about ٠ another person).

Who can join an Academy listserv?

Anyone is free to join at all levels of experience or seniority. Most SIGs permit non-members. Please visit the SIG-dedicated pages on the Academy website for details on SIG joining requirements: https://www.clpsychiatry.org/sigs/, or simply edit your Academy profile via the Academy website.

How to post to a listserv

Send an email to the listserv email as noted below, but you must already be subscribed to a SIG to post to <u>it</u>.

The email associated with your Academy member profile is that to which emails are sent and received. As our listservs are private to subscribers, the SIG software performs email matching as a means of subscriber verification and will automatically reject emails it cannot confirm.

Need to change your email? Academy members log-on to your profile at the Academy website: https://www.clpsychiatry.org/. Non-members: please email the executive office at info@CLpsychiatry.org and we will modify your subscription email for you. Sorry, even though you may store multiple emails with your Academy profile only your primary email can be used for your listserv subscription.

Email changes are not instant but post to the listserv around midnight US Eastern Time each night.

Unsubscribing

Unsubscribe from a SIG via your Academy member profile or notify the executive office at sigadmin@clpsychiatry.org. Changes take 24 hours to post. Sorry, you cannot unsubscribe by posting an unsubscribe request to the listserv.

Replying to a message

'Reply' to correspond only with an email author; 'Reply All' will copy the listserv and be shared with all subscribers. Personal comments should be sent directly to the person, not the entire list.

Delete the original message in your replies, or just a leave a few lines to recall the topic you're addressing, but you do not need to include the entire message(s).

Sharing documents

You can email commonly used documents (MS-Office files, such as Word, Excel, PowerPoint), PDFs, and some image files, up to 3MB in size. The size restriction is to prevent our server from being overloaded if someone accidentally sends an overly large file.

Security

The Academy operates a virus scanner for all emails and attachments but, as no system is perfect, please exercise care when receiving an attachment through the list. We recommend you download any attachment to your hard drive and run a virus scan on it before opening it.

Archives

The Academy maintains searchable archives of all messages posted to our lists; the location of the archive can be found at the bottom of every email you receive from the list. Simply click the link to visit it. All Academy lists were migrated to a new platform in September 2019 and the archives were wiped and



restarted. Therefore, archives only start from September 2019 if the SIG existed at this time, or from when the SIG listserv was created.

Format Guidelines

The less formatting the better; many different email clients will be used to read list postings. Some of those could be plain text email readers that struggle with formatting.

Compatibility

The enormous variety of email readers means we are unable to guarantee you will be able to read listserv postings on your preferred device. Our limited testing suggests that, if your service or device is running its very latest version, most individuals will be able to receive, read and reply to listserv postings. If your preferred device is proving uncooperative, please try another device, software or app.

AOL/Yahoo

Due to email handling policies enabled by AOL and Yahoo, emails from these addresses may behave in unexpected ways, including emails not being processed correctly by the listserv; emails being uncontrollably deleted or discarded; messages displaying incorrectly; causing distribution problems with the list; causing disruption to other users; or interfering with list email distribution. We strongly encourage AOL and Yahoo customers to use a different email if you have one available. See earlier text in this FAQ for directions on how to change your email. Gmail

As a "decluttering" measure on your behalf, Gmail automatically discards your copy of any email you send to a list, rationalizing that your "sent" copy already constitutes the information you need and classifying the list email as a superfluous identical copy. This behavior cannot be changed and is documented by Google here: https://support.google.com/a/answer/1703601?hl=en
