How to Complete Your Session Evaluations to Claim Your CME Credits

1. Access the Evaluation process using either of the following:

In the meeting app, look for the Evaluation button on the home screen, or footer menu.

On the conference microsite, look for the Evaluation option in the left navigation pane.

2. Login into the Evaluation module using your ACLP profile credentials.

3. The Evaluation process will present you with three tasks to complete to obtain your CME certificate:

- Complete your profile: identify learner type, subspecialty and, for ABPN records verification purposes, your date of birth. This last item is optional.
- Select the sessions you attended for which you are claiming CME credit. For each session you claim, you will be asked to complete an evaluation of the session content and each speaker. Remember to click "Submit"! An evaluation must be completed for you to receive your CME credit.
- Complete the meeting evaluation.

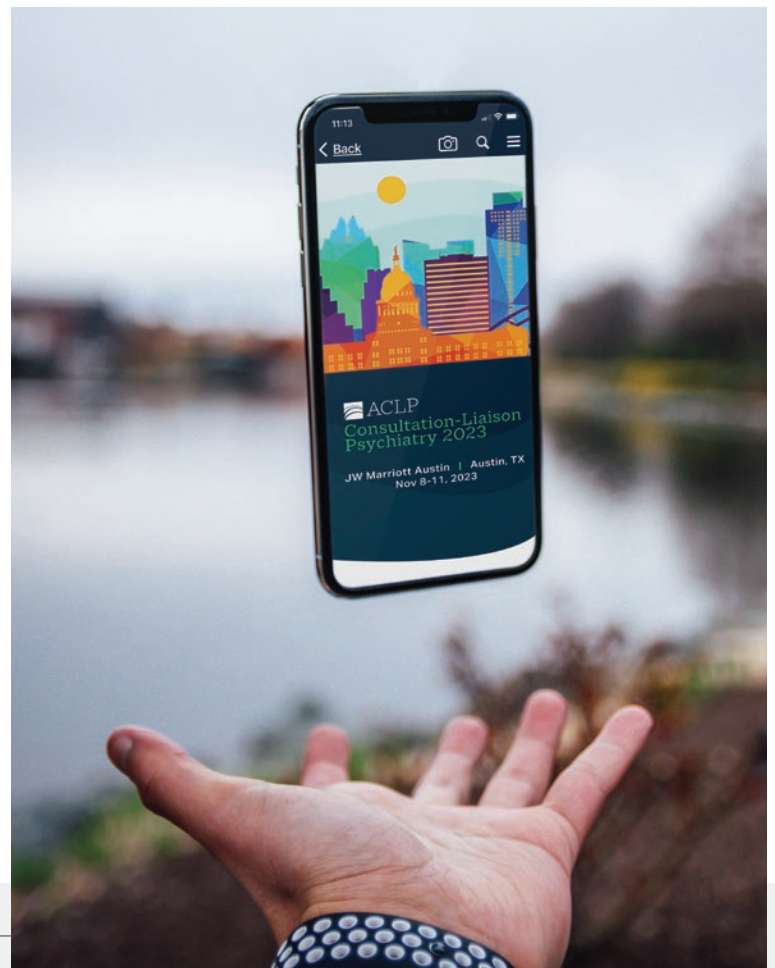
Once all three are done, you can print, download, and/or email yourself your CME document.

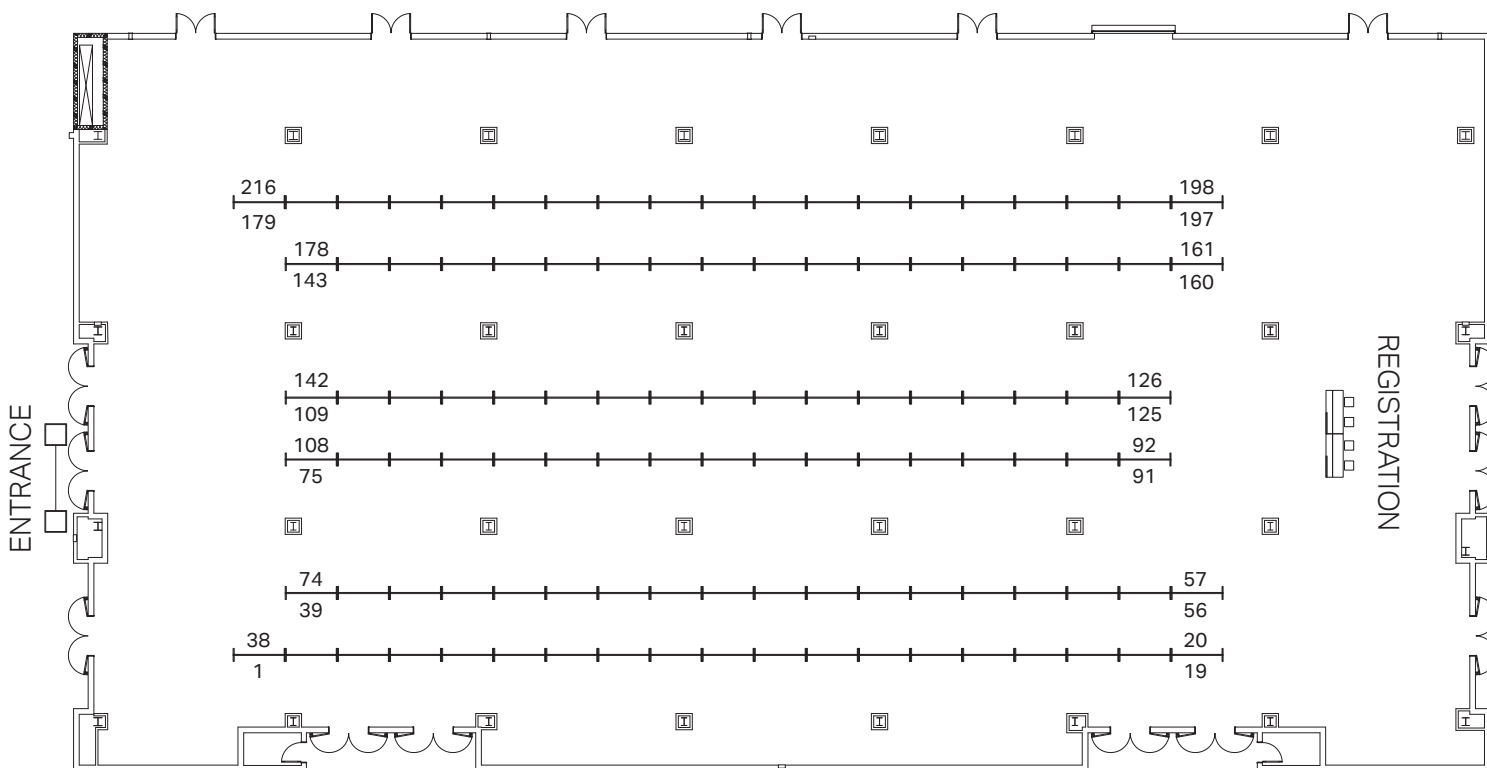
