

## Concise Guide to Maintenance of Certification

## Academy of Consultation-Liaison Psychiatry MOC Subcommittee

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This guide was created to facilitate navigation of the MOC process and to highlight main points. While every effort was made to ensure the accuracy of the information provided, the ABPN is the final authority on all requirements and responsibility ultimately rests with the individual for ensuring appropriate and timely completion of all activities (contact the ABPN directly with <u>Questions</u>).

With the launch of the new assessment pathway, all current 3-year blocks have been automatically reset to 2022–2024. Diplomates who were issued a 10-year certificate and due for a recertification exam in 2020 and/or 2021 will need to pass the traditional exam or the article exams by the end of 2022.

<u>Self-assessment</u> credits contribute to the overall number of CME credits, and this requirement can be fulfilled by completing the annual ACLP pre-conference exam.			
Includes a one-time <u>patient safety activity</u> that applies to all pathways if certified in 2017 or later.
